“Kihachiro Okura and the Okura Museum of Art — The Life of A Businessman and Art Collector”

Born in 1837 in present-day Shibata, Niigata, Kihachiro Okura was one of Japan's leading early industrialists. He came to Edo (Tokyo) at the age of 18 to study business amid the upheaval of the late Edo period. At the beginning of the Meiji period, Okura played an important role in Japan's industrial development. He was also active in education, philanthropy and cultural preservation. The exhibition throws light on Okura's personality through a display of his art collection and historical documents, which reveal his varied tastes.

Born in Nanjing, Xu Ke graduated from Beijing's Central Conservatory of Music in 1982. After living and performing in Japan for several years, Xu Ke moved to the United States in 1996, where he played the *erhu* in Yo-Yo Ma's "Silk Road" project. Since returning to Japan in 2004, Xu Ke has maintained a busy performance schedule in Japan, China, and the U.S. His music has thrilled listeners from various countries by bringing out the full appeal of the *erhu* with his stunning performance.
